*Grains from the Past Preserving the Past; Preparing for the future*— Only one of our many proceedings books wears a red cover, so of course as I scanned over the books this month and realized that I needed to move forward into more current years, I chose that red book—the Proceedings of 1967. I found that the Grand Chapter was joining in the "centennial celebration"—100 years of statehood for Nebraska. I also found the members planning ahead in preparation of the Grand Chapter's 100 years which would occur in eight years—1975. Sister Jane Owen was appointed Grand Chapter Historian. Sister Jane in a very thorough manner wrote a 10 ½ page report on the history of our Order which was contained in that red proceedings book. Sister Jane's work was published on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our Grand Chapter. Many of our Chapters still have that white "Harvest of Memories" book that was a tribute to 100 years of loving service by Eastern Star members during our first 100 years.
