Resolutions passed at Grand Chapter Session

1. Twenty-five percent of all Chartered Chapters shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at Grand Chapter of Nebraska.
2. A Masonic Lodge certificate, properly attested, from a legally constituted Masonic Lodge recognized by the Nebraska Grand Lodge, shall constitute lawful evidence of eligibility of a Master Mason or his female relatives within the proper degrees of relationship, to become members of the Order. Such evidence must accompany each Petition for Degrees before it can be received by a Chapter. The above certification must be retained with the petition for a permanent record.
