



NEBRASKA PASSPORT PROGRAM

Purpose: The Nebraska Passport program is to encourage more interaction among all Masonic bodies.

Goal: Each member participating is to attend at least 1 event outside their organization each month.

To get started:

- 1) Get a printed passport either at your Organization's meeting or download from the OES website.
- 2) Go and visit other Masonic Organizations' events. It does not have to be a meeting. Just an event.
- 3) Make sure a member from the Organization event you are attending dates, initials, and writes what event you were at.
- 4) Events are posted through the various Organizations' websites or just check with your organization's secretary for communications received. We will try to have events that we know about posted on the NE OES Website or through the Group Facebook page.
- 5) You will be awarded points for each event/meeting you attend outside of your own Chapter/Lodge/Bethel/Assembly/etc.
 - 1 point for each event/meeting within your organization
 - 2 points for each event/meeting outside your organization

Points will be tallied. The Fraternal Relations Committee will then recognize the Top 10 participants from each Masonic Organization and award prizes at the next Grand Chapter.

Please return your completed Nebraska Passports postmarked no later than March 31st to address shown below.
