We are hopeful that we will be able to move forward with the event and are

making plans as if the event is going to take place. The CHIP Board has put together a plan for the protection of our volunteers and the families that attend the event. Eastern Star members are busy sewing and will be donating cloth masks for all volunteers, Craftsmen Lodge No. 314 in Lincoln is 3D printing and donating face shields for our dental personnel, we are reducing the number of computer stations in the room from six to three to allow for social distancing, we will be limiting the number of volunteers accepted per shift and the number of people that will be allowed in the room at one time, and we are looking at the possibility of scheduling times for families to go through the event to control the flow of participants.

We need **28 volunteers** per day to fill the shifts each day. We will be limiting it to that maximum number of volunteers per day, so register early to get your preferred day and time.
